



SSA SURF SCHOOL ACCREDITATION PROCESS 2016

To register as an accredited SSA Surf School the following conditions must be met:

- At least 80% of the coaches working at the Surf School must be accredited coaches.
- The Surf School must submit documented Standard Operating Procedures to SSA.
- The Surf School must have a Medical Kit & charged cell phone on hand during every lesson.
- Soft surfboards must be used when instructing beginners or children.

Accredited Surf Schools will receive the following:

- A certificate of Accreditation.
- Two large SSA Stickers.
- The right to advertise the Surf School as a “Surfing South Africa Accredited Surf School “ accompanied by the Surfing South Africa logo.
- A listing on the SSA Surf School Register on www.surfingsouthafrica.co.za
- Two unique SSA “SURF COACH” rash vests (once off on initial registration).

All individuals who receive lessons at an SSA Accredited Surf School will be entitled to SSA Social Membership through the Surf School.

The initial registration fee is R1200-00 and the annual renewal fee is R600-00
